

A. Mandate

The National Defense Act of 1935 provides for the Mandate of the Philippine Military Academy. Article IV, Section 30 of the said law states that, "There shall be established a military training school to be named the Philippine Military Academy, for the training of selected candidates for permanent commission in the Regular Force. The student body in the Military Academy shall be known as the Cadet Corps of the Armed Forces of the Philippines."

B. Vision

By 2028, the Philippine Military Academy shall have reached the international standards for military academies in producing principled and competent military officers.

C. Mission

To instruct, train and develop the cadets so that each graduate shall possess the character, the broad and basic military skills, and the education essential to the successful pursuit of a progressive military career.
